1. Resolve that the monthly meetings of the Sonoma County Law Enforcement Chiefs' Association be open to the public and be conducted on the record under Brown Act type rules.

(Law enforcement policies in Sonoma County must cease to be made behind closed doors!)

2. Resolve that all police and sheriff sex crime reports and domestic violence crime reports be sent to the District Attorney's Office for review.

(Our police and sheriff must stop burying the overwhelming majority of violence against women and children crime reports in their departments without sending these reports to the DA's office for review.)

- 3. Resolve to form a representative citizen group with veto power to work with officials on the recruiting, hiring, training, and promotion of all law enforcement officers in your community. (Communities must have meaningful input on which individuals can and cannot wield police powers.)
- 4. Resolve that the District Attorney's Office, as well as police and Sheriff's departments, be included for review in any law enforcement Civilian Review Boards formed in Sonoma County.
